

Exercise Salish Sea 2017

Notice of Road Closure

EXERCISE SALISH SEA is an interagency emergency response exercise led by Canadian Coast Guard (CCG) and Emergency Management BC taking place on and around Saltspring Island. The primary objective of Exercise Salish Sea is to test the validity of the BC Emergency Marine response to a MAJMAR and to support the Gulf Islands Emergency Social Services providing experiential training for a large scale emergency.

Most of the on land action will take place on and around Fernwood Dock. To ensure the safety of the First Responders, volunteers and Exercise staff, the roads around this area will be closed on Wednesday October 25th 2017 from 7am to approximately 5pm.

There will be access to local residences and any open businesses that may be affected however it will be limited. To this end for those homes nearest the dock we would ask that if at all possible, your vehicle is staged further down the road. We appreciate that this will not be possible for everyone.

The roads impacted are as follows:

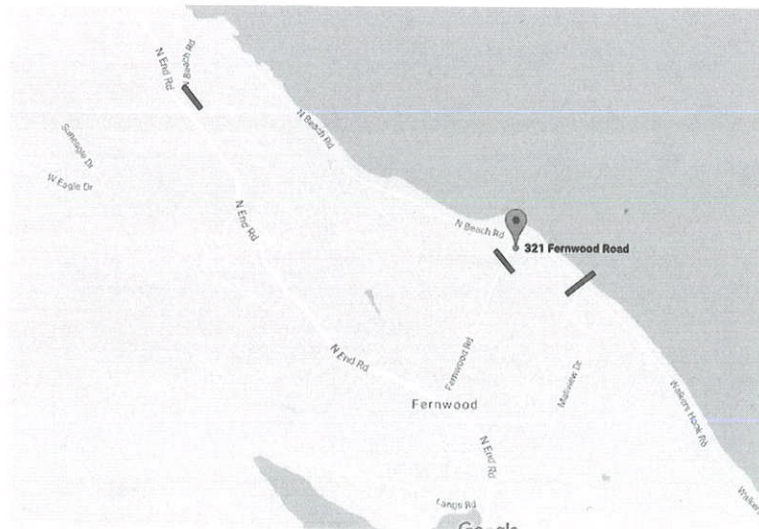
North Beach Road closed from connection with North End Road to intersection at Fernwood Road and Walkers Hook road. There will be restricted access within 200 feet of the intersection, the remainder of the road is closed to prevent traffic turning onto North Beach Road and should not hamper residents of North Beach Road travelling to and from North End Road.

Walkers Hook Road will be closed from the intersection with Fernwood Road and North Beach Road up to Maliview Road. There will be restricted access in the area within 100 feet of Fernwood Dock.

Fernwood Road will be closed from Delong Terrace to the intersection with North Beach Road and Walkers Hook Road.

The intersection will be entirely blocked and the transit service will be rerouted through Maliview Road.
