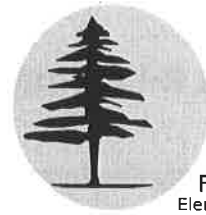


Saplings K-1 Nature Class Supply List

Note: Your class teacher may make additional supply requests specific to class needs and teacher preference.

Classroom Supplies

- 1 package of quality pre-sharpened pencils
- 1 package of pre-sharpened pencil crayons
- 1 package of felt markers (thick or thin)
- 1 package of wax crayons
- 4 good quality large glue sticks (UHU is best)
- 1 pair of children's sized scissors
- \$30 school supply fee (per child) - the supply fee will be put towards ordering class supplies; folders, workbooks, art supplies, etc. Please send in money on the first day of school.

Clothing and Gear - These items are really important for your child's comfort!

Please label all clothing and gear with your child's name. Ensure gear is waterproof and not just water resistant. Please bring all of these items on the first day of school.

Basics

- 1 cloth/drawstring **bag** for spare change of clothes (to be left at school on your child's hook)
- 1 full set of **spare clothes** including underwear & extra socks (2-3 pairs)
- 1 pair non-marking **runners** to be used as indoor/gym shoes
- 1 sturdy, properly sized **backpack** (must fit water bottle, lunch kit, and jacket/extra layers)
- 1 water **bottle** with a secure lid (metal or plastic only)

Outdoor Clothing - To Stay Dry

It is best if these items can stay at school. If they make their way home please return promptly.

- 1 pair **waterproof pants**
- 1 **waterproof raincoat**
- 1 pair **rain boots**

Outdoor Clothing - To Stay Warm

As these items are more seasonal in nature they can be brought to school when the weather starts to cool down, likely in late October or early November.

- 1 pair **thermal socks** made of wool/wool blend (leave them at school to wear in rain boots)
- 1 **thermal layer**; fleece jacket; down-filled vest or coat; or thick wool sweater
- 1 fleece or wool **toque**
- 1 pair waterproof **gloves/mittens**

Hiking boots or sturdy outside runners are also recommended (in addition to rain boots).

Have extra gear? Need help with gear? Proper footwear and clothing for the outdoors enables your child to fully participate in our outdoor program. If your child has outgrown any gear (and it's in reasonable condition) please consider donating it to the Nature Classes. We can make it available to those families who need help acquiring quality gear, and/or make it available as spares.
