


HOW TO ORDER: Go Online, following steps below, and fill in bottom of form and return this form and payment to your child's classroom teacher.

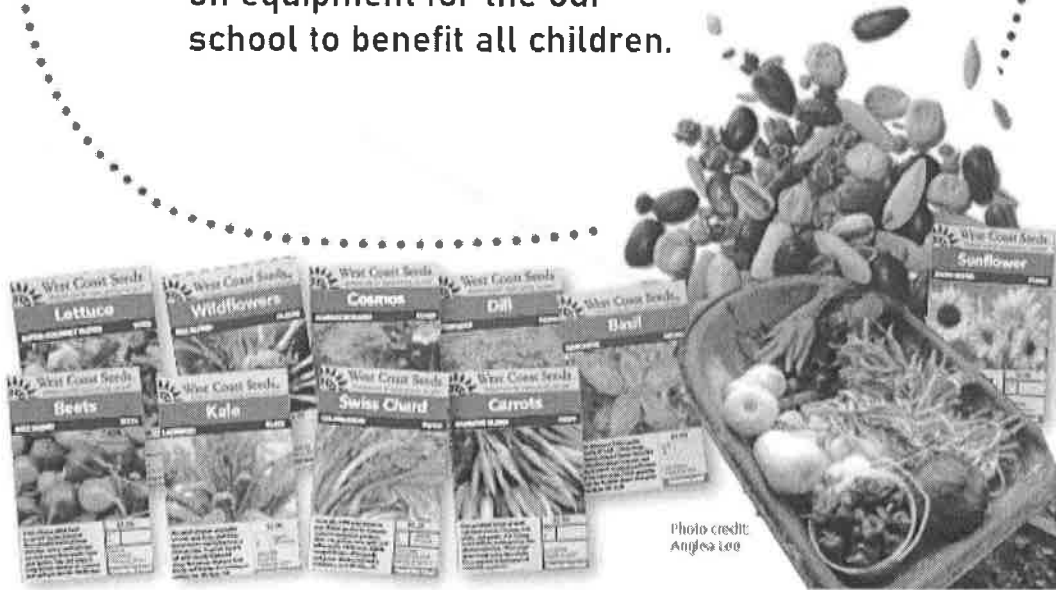

Black Beauty Zucchini SQ710

- OP, 50 days
- Tender texture and excellent flavour
- The open bush grows to 60cm (2'4")



Delicata Squash SQ737

- OP, 100 days
- Mild tasting, thin-skinned, delicate flavour
- 500g (1 lb) fruits
- Stores well for months after harvesting.
- Oblong and creamy white, with green bands



Waltham Butternut Squash SQ761

- OP, 110 days
- AAS Winner
- Produce uniform fruits with creamy, rich, dry, yellow-orange flesh
- Store for as long as six months



Celebration Swiss Chard SW753

- OP, 60 days
- All-America Selections winner
- Thick red, yellow, rose, gold, and white stems bear slightly savoyed leaves
- Can be planted in large containers



Early Cascade Tomatoes TM769

- OP, 62 days
- Vine
- Excellent flavour and early maturity
- Productive bright red, thin-skinned



Amish Paste Tomatoes TM784

- OP, 70-75 days
- Vine
- Firm, deep red heartloom tomatoes can be up to 22.7g (0.8oz) each



Gold Nugget Tomatoes TM817

- OP, 60 days
- Bush
- Plants grow to 1m (3') covered with 20cm (1") diameter, round, yellow



Hakurei Turnips TR815

- F1, 35 days
- Smooth and pretty gourmet turnips
- Japanese breeding produces uniform, globe-shaped roots with snow-white
